## **SUMMARY of presentation (mains ideas developed in the language that you prefer) :**

In the frame of the Ecological Continuum Project, ECONNECT and the Platform Ecological Network of the Alpine Convention various tools were developed in order to facilitate and harmonise the work carried out throughout the Alps aiming at creating a transalpine ecological network. Thus, a common methodology was elaborated in cooperation with a large group of scientists from all alpine countries. This methodology as well as a guideline is the basic tool for the work in the alpine pilot regions. In the same spirit, a catalogue of measures was developed. This document gathers a large number of measures that can contribute to the creation on local and regional ecological networks such as for example agricultural, landscape planning or nature protection measures. A research tool offers the possibility to choose the best adapted measures to the specific local situation by using various selection criteria. Further more, a number of communication tool were developed in order to make the topic of ecological connectivity more know among the stakeholders of the pilot regions and the large public in and outside the Alps.
