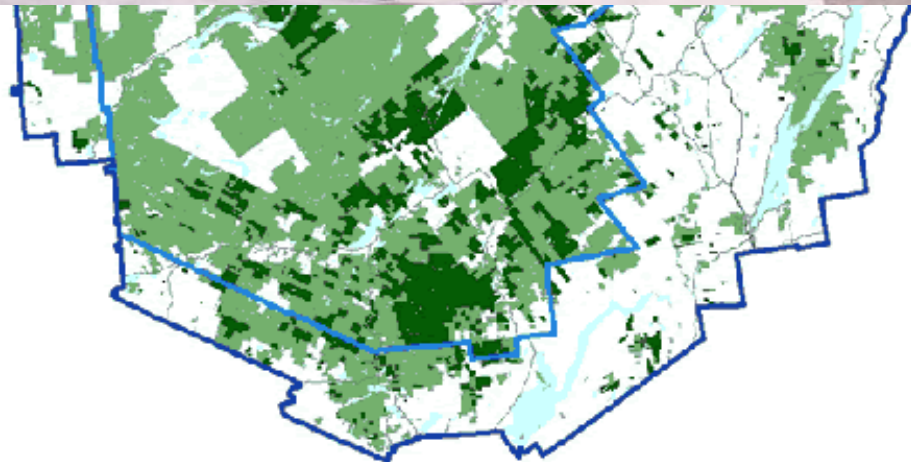

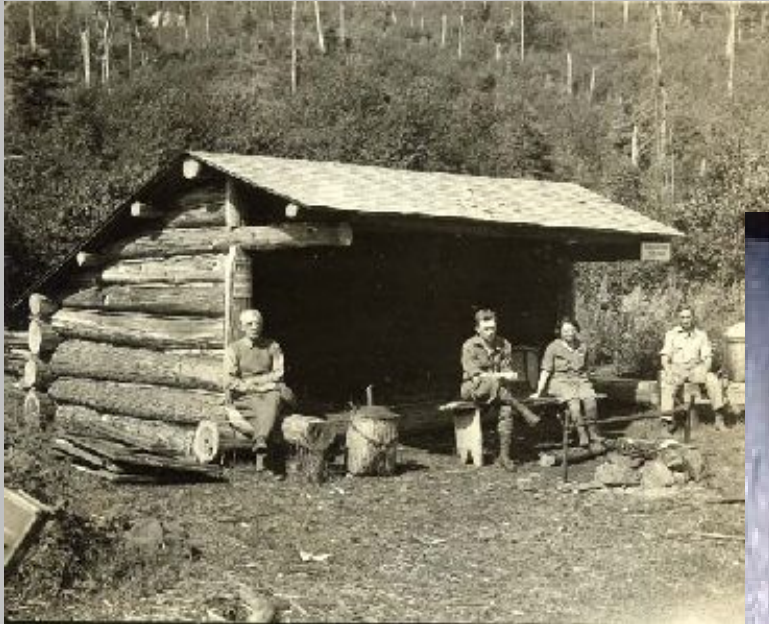
- 1892 Adirondack Park Boundary

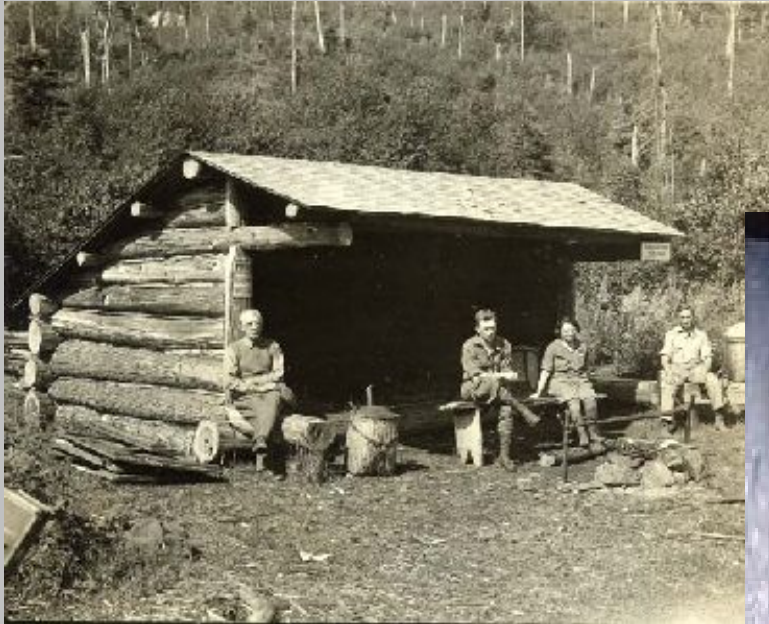




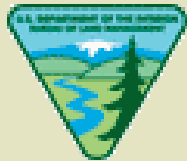
