**Anerkennung des Ranger-Berufs durch die Internationale Arbeitsorganisation (ILO).**

### Regierungen und politische Entscheidungsträger:

- 1 Sollten Ranger\*innen als systemrelevante Arbeitskräfte für die planetare Gesundheit anerkannt werden.
- 2 Sollten ihre zentrale Rolle bei der Erfüllung globaler Verpflichtungen würdigen.
- 3 Sollten Ressourcen bereitstellen, um die diversen Fähigkeiten von Ranger\*innen zu fördern.
- 4 Sollten Schutzgebietsverwaltungen und Organisationen bei der Professionalisierung der Ranger\*innen unterstützen.

### Arbeitgeber sollten hochwertige Arbeitsbedingungen sicherstellen, durch:

- 1 Zugang zu hochwertiger Erste-Hilfe
- 2 Bereitstellung von Lebensversicherungen
- 3 Grundlegende Gesundheits- und Sicherheitsleistungen
- 4 Angemessene Ausrüstung, Technologie
- 5 Passendes und regelmäßiges Training
- 6 Angemessene Sicherheitsvorkehrungen und Richtlinien

- 1 Mitgliedschaft in Ranger Verbänden
- 2 Aktive Beteiligung an zukünftigen State-of-the-Ranger-Erhebungen

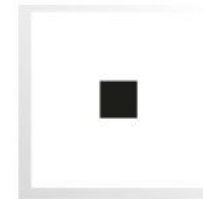
